Since its founding in 1940, the GHCA has been a voluntary organization, serving more than 300 homeowners.

Membership Eligibility and How to Join

Membership in the Green Hill Civic Association is open to all property owners within the area bordered by Green Hill Beach Road (west), Matunuck Schoolhouse Road (north), State conservation lands (east), and the Atlantic Ocean (south). Annual dues are \$125 per household. Dues are payable annually in April-May. To join and pay your initial dues, please contact Treasurer Steve Shaknaitis at **shaknaitiss@gmail.com**.

Benefits of Membership

- Invitations to all social events, including the summer kick-off dinner and annual summer picnic.
- Access to the easement beach area at the end of Green Hill Avenue (established by law in 2003).
- Access to the bocce court, horseshoe pit, picnic tables and GHCA sports equipment storage shed at the Recreation Area on Green Hill Beach Road.
- Eligibility for access to the private tennis and pickleball courts at the Recreation Area (additional fee)
- Access to the Green Hill Pond boat launch and communal kayaks, with privately-owned kayak storage for properly tagged member boats.
- Annual newsletter (digital) with updates and special editions.
- Voting rights at association meetings held in June and August, where members can influence decisions and connect with neighbors.

Your annual membership dues support the GHCA's operating fund, covering:

- Social events throughout the season
- Liability insurance for GHCA owned properties
- Taxes on the Boat Launch and Recreation Area
- Maintenance of the pond boat launch and recreation areas
- Purchase of benches, bike racks, and other essentials
- Accounting and administrative costs
- Newsletter production and distribution
- Website hosting fees
- Miscellaneous expenses
- Signage at the beach, boat launch, and recreation areas

GHCA Community Areas

Beach Use Information

Green Hill Avenue Beach

The Green Hill Avenue Beach is located at the end of Green Hill Avenue. It is very rocky, with swimming sometimes possible at low tide. As part of a legal settlement in 2003, GHCA members, along with several property owners, have deeded access to the beach at the end of Green Hill Avenue. There is no lifeguard, and swimming is at your own risk.

Coast Guard Avenue Beach

The Coast Guard Avenue beach is located at the end of Coast Guard Avenue and is a good spot for relaxing & beachside leisure. The parking lot at Coast Guard Avenue is reserved for members of the Hill Association, a separate local group with overlapping membership eligibility. There is no lifeguard, and swimming is at your own risk.

When on the beaches, please be mindful of others, stay safe, be courteous and have fun.

Dogs are not permitted on Green Hill beaches in season until after 4 p.m. Observe South Kingstown leash laws and pick up after your pet. Do not leave dog poop bags *anywhere* in Green Hill except in trash cans.

Boat Launch

The GHCA owns and maintains a boat launch on Green Hill Pond, accessible from lower Green Hill Beach Road (entrance marked by signs). It's ideal for launching canoes, kayaks, and other small, shallow-draft, non-motor watercraft for use on Green Hill and Ninigret Ponds, which are connected by a channel at Charlestown Beach Road.

The boat launch is open to GHCA members in good standing, their tenants, and guests. Member craft (including paddle boards & windsurfers) must display a current calendar-year sticker, available from the Boat Launch Commodore after dues are paid. Boat racks for kayaks are assigned each year and available from Memorial Day through Thanksgiving weekend.

There is a limited number of communal kayaks, safety jackets and paddles available for borrowing in the shed next to the tennis courts. These must be returned in clean condition after each use and locked in the shed. Shed keys are distributed when you get a sticker for your kayak or other watercraft.

GHCA Tennis & Pickleball Courts

The Civic Association, through its Tennis Committee, owns and maintains two tennis and pickleball courts near the boat launch. These courts are available to all dues-current members, with an additional fee for Tennis and Pickleball membership. The fee helps cover court maintenance, groundskeeping, fencing, and resurfacing. The Tennis and Pickleball groups organize periodic round-robin play for various skill levels as well as social events each summer.

GHCA Recreation Area

Adjacent to the tennis courts is a recreation area with a bocce court, horseshoe pit, and picnic tables. Equipment for both games is stored in the shed near the courts. Members are invited to enjoy the space and are asked to rake the bocce court and return equipment to the shed after use.
